ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM POLICY

I. Application

Criteria:

- A. Grade point average of 3.2 or better (un-weighted) (Provide Transcripts)
- B. Accepted to at least one accredited Jr. College, College or University (Provide Acceptance Letter)
- C. Must be a graduating senior of any High School in Lee County, including home schooled graduating seniors
- D. No immediate family may be a member of the Rotary
- E. Active involvement in the school and the community
- F. **Must be a Cape Coral resident and U.S. Citizen**

II. Scholarships Evaluation Process

A. Phase I – Committee Review of Written Application

Purpose: Review of all written applications by the full scholarship committee to select a short list of finalists for Phase II interviews.

Evaluation based on the written articulation of the following criteria:

1. Academic standing
2. Academic history
3. School involvement and achievements
4. Community involvement and achievements
5. Career and academic goals
6. Three letters of recommendation (non-family)

B. Phase II – Personal Interview

Purpose: Interview of the individual finalist by the full scholarship committee.

Evaluation of personality and the verbal articulation of the following criteria:

1. Academic standing
2. Academic history
3. School involvement and achievements
4. Community involvement and achievements
5. Career and academic goals

* NOTE: In the event of a tie, financial need shall prevail!
